**The plan for middle school electives is similar to the plan for the rest of the school; the teachers will come to the classroom for each elective except for P.E..**



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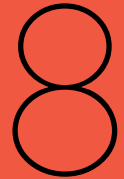


## How will sports be affected?

**4<sup>th</sup>-8<sup>th</sup>:**

- **Must wear a face mask in the building**
- **When less than 6 feet apart**
