



COVID-19 Health & Safety Policy

To ensure the safety of students, faculty and staff as we welcome you back to school, our promise to the St Andrew community is that we will continue to be a leader in safe sanitation practices. All Food 4 Life team members are certified in safe food handling and preparation and we are providing additional training and monitoring on appropriate cleaning and disinfecting and hygiene to ensure the safety of those we serve. We will comply with state and local orders by requiring face coverings to be worn by employees as well as taking daily temperature checks. Patrons are asked to help us by maintaining at least 6 feet of distance from others in food distribution and cashier lines. In addition, we ask that for the safety of everyone and to allow us to maintain the appropriate distance to make payments to your account online or by check as we aim to keep cash handling to a minimum.

We will not have condiments, flatware or cups available for self-serve. We will provide condiments in single use (non-reusable) portions. Packaged, individual flatware packets with napkins will also be available.

All employees must pass a health screening before coming into the kitchen. Employees will wash or sanitize their hands upon entering the kitchen and between interactions with customers. We will clean and disinfect work areas and surfaces regularly. We will also clean and disinfect each serving and cashier area after every lunch period. We will post our COVID-19 Health & Safety Policy, at our entrances and display readily visible signage to remind everyone of best hygiene practices.

We will work closely with the St Andrew administration to maintain a healthy environment for children while providing professional food service. We will get through this together!
