Monica Ashour, a 1979 alum of SAS and Executive Director and National Speaker for the Theology of the Body Evangelization Team, Inc. (TOBET) is working to spread the message of Pope John Paul II's teaching - The Theology of the Body (TOB). She and members of her non-profit organization go around to different youth groups, parishes, single and married groups to spread this message of hope and healing.

Monica speaks about the solid education that SAS gave her in growing up.

"Schools are to build upon the foundation that parents give to their children; SAS did just that. The teachers, administration, and staff worked us hard to be solid in academics with a deep understanding of the Catholic faith. I am indebted to Saint Andrew and am so grateful for the sacrifices my parents, Paul and Doris Ashour, made to send me and my siblings there."

Monica is the author of the *Parent's Guide for Theology of the Body for Teens: Middle School Edition* by Ascension Press. She is

also working on another book that will include of 500 diagrams she created to help elucidate the Truths of the Catholic faith.

Under Miss Ashour's guidance, TOBET has launched two highly successful outreaches: TOBET4/ByTeens and TheREVOLUTION. TOBET4/By Teens uses teenagers to present information to their peers through talks, funny skits, and poignant dramas. It captures the hearts and minds of teens, helping them to understand and live the truth of their sexuality.

TheREVOLUTION focuses on the college age group and teaches college students how to reach the campus at large. With highly intense media presentations followed by peer-led discussion groups on the Theology of the Body, the REVOLUTION captivates college students who are longing for the truth yet find themselves in the midst of wrongful societal norms.

Saint Andrew forms students to be future leaders and to live their faith. Monica Ashour is one of them. She and some of her TOBET interns will be reaching our current students at two presentations, for students and parents in January 2012. Meanwhile, in November Monica will travel to Rome as she presents a paper entitled, "How to Teach Teens the Theology of the Body".

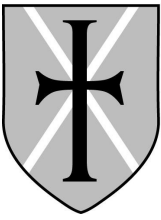

- 700 students in Pre-School thru 8th grades.
- 4 sections of Kindergarten feeding into 3 sections of all other grades.
- 88% Catholic.
- 99.9% are accepted to Nolan Catholic High School every year.
- 60% to 80% of SAS 8th graders go to Nolan Catholic High School.
- 55% to 70% of SAS 7th graders are Duke Scholars, scoring 95+% on certain subtests of the Iowa Basic Test
- Tuition is \$500/month for one Catholic student.
- SAS students, faculty, and parents donated 10,000 pounds of food for Social Ministry Outreach in Saint Andrew Parish at the school's weekly Masses.
