Cafeteria and Recess

Cafeteria Expectations:

- Students arrive at the cafeteria at the assigned lunch times, not early
- Students grades K-5 sit with their homeroom
- Students grades 6-8 are not required to sit with homerooms (this privilege can be revoked if behavior is poor)
- All students are expected to use table manners
- The volume should be appropriate and never too loud
- Students are allowed to make purchases until five minutes prior to being released
- The last five minutes of the lunch period should be in complete silence
- During the last five minutes, students should be released by table or row to throw their trash and begin cleaning
- Students should remain in silence until exiting the cafeteria
- Grade level teachers should be consistent regarding cafeteria expectations

Recess Expectations

- Students must replace all equipment on the cart at the end of recess
- Students should be in the building and ready to return to class at the end of the recess period
- No physical games during recess
- Teachers should spread out around the playground and monitor
- Organized sports (soccer, etc.) must contain ZERO contact and be directly monitored by a faculty member at all times
- Students are allowed to bring their own balls but the school is not responsible for lost/stolen/damaged items
- Teachers may approve other recess items such as cards, etc.
- Students must be monitored or escorted by a teacher to retrieve balls that are kicked out of playground area
